





Baby Boomers reach age 65

Retiree Associations

- Similar to Alumni Associations
- Membership-based
- Unique entity but affiliated with university
- Sometimes partially campus-supported





Emeriti/Retiree Centers

- Usually campus-funded
- Office of record for retirees
- Usually not membershipbased; serve all retirees
- Often provide administrative support to retiree associations





Emeriti Colleges

- Usually hybrid funding: campus funded, endowment, foundation, membership/fee-based
- Scholarship & research focused
- Classes, speakers' bureaus, publications, etc.
